## MESSAGE TO MEMBERS OF ESCAP SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS NETWORK

### **Ninth Asia-Pacific Forum on Sustainable Development Bangkok and online, 28 to 31 March 2022**

I have the honour to invite you to designate members of the ESCAP Sustainable Business Network to attend the Ninth Asia-Pacific Forum on Sustainable Development, which will be held at the United Nations Conference Centre in Bangkok and online from 28 to 31 March 2022.

Guided by the theme “Building back better from COVID-19 while advancing the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda in Asia and the Pacific” and with the overall objective of shaping regional priorities, the Forum will assess the progress towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and will consider a range of perspectives for accelerating transformations and facilitate exchange of knowledge, good practices and policy solutions.

This Forum will review the regional progress towards attainment of Sustainable Development Goal 4 (quality education), Goal 5 (gender equality), Goal 14 (life below water), Goal 15 (life on land) and Goal 17 (partnerships for the Goals) and their interlinkages with the other Goals. It will also consider the role of the United Nations system in supporting the implementation of the 2030 Agenda; and reflect on the national, regional and global dimensions of the follow-up and review, through the presentation of voluntary national reviews.

As the most inclusive regional platform on sustainable development in Asia and the Pacific, the Forum also serves as a preparatory event for the 2022 high-level political forum on sustainable development. The outcome of the Forum will also inform the deliberations at the seventy-eight session of the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific.
