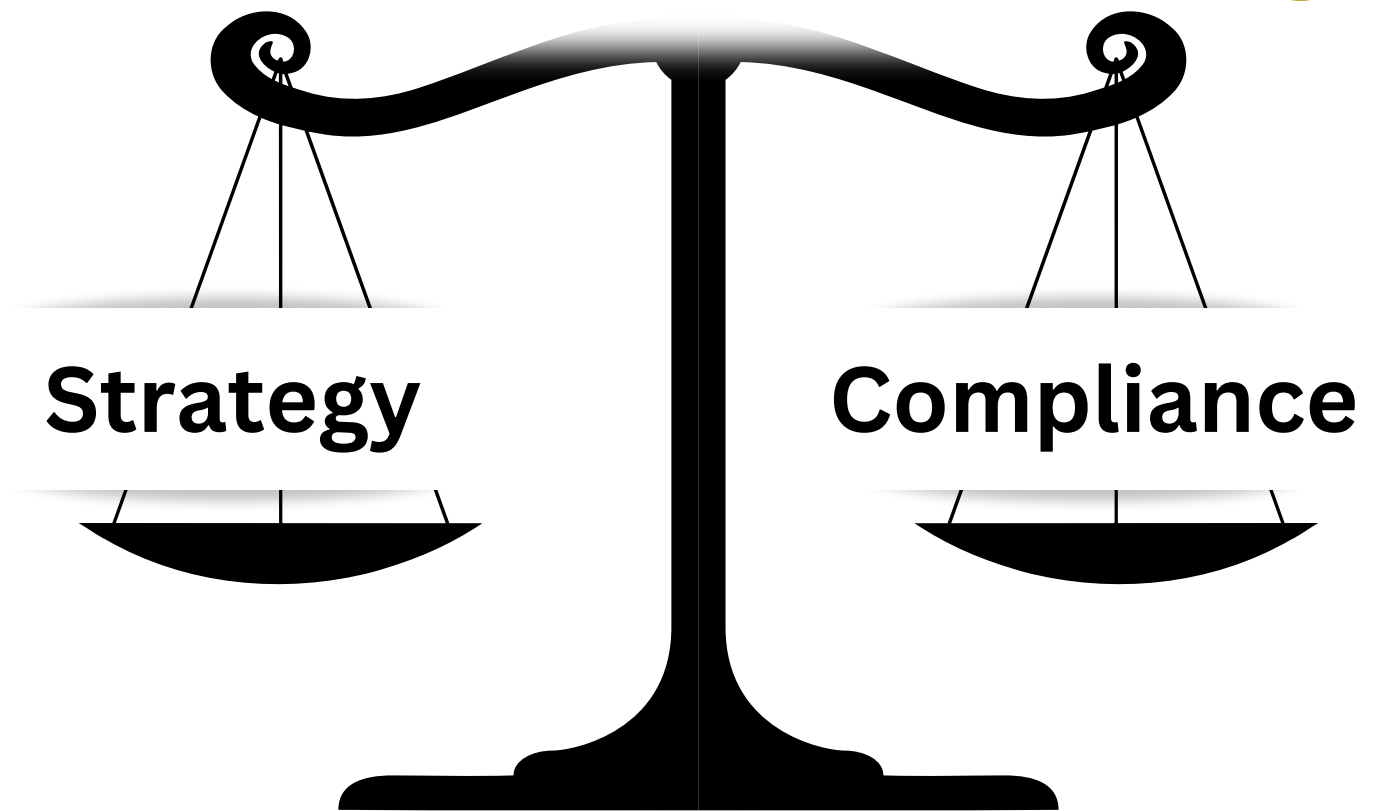

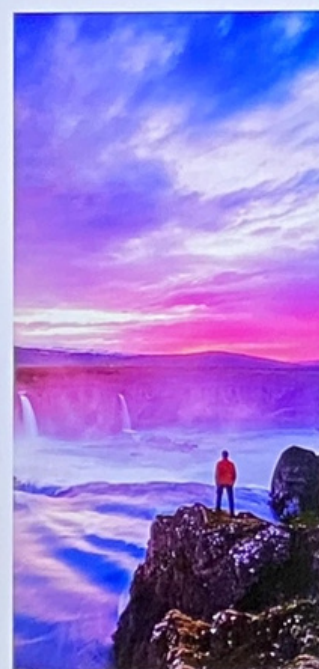

Key consideration for sustainable supply chain decarbonisation



- 01** Have you setup mechanisms to map, define and assess sustainability risks within your supply chain?
 Sustainability risks should be incorporated in supply chain risk management. Working groups establishing core sustainability objectives between procurement and sustainability personnel etc., could be foundational (e.g. circularity, transition to clean energy etc)
- 02** Does your supply risk management framework identify and flag substantial scope 3 emissions supplier contributors?
 As scope 3 emission become more relevant in reporting, carbon footprint should be factored into the selection criteria for particularly critical suppliers (tier 1 suppliers).
- 03** How are you engaging with suppliers on climate action?
 Sustainable supply chains requires active advocacy and communication with suppliers on ESG issues. Leveraging expertise with internal and external organizations, workshops, circulars, communiqués could be used to ensure suppliers are supported to build sustainability capability and incentivised to reduce carbon decarbonize their processes as well as pass on these principles to their own suppliers
